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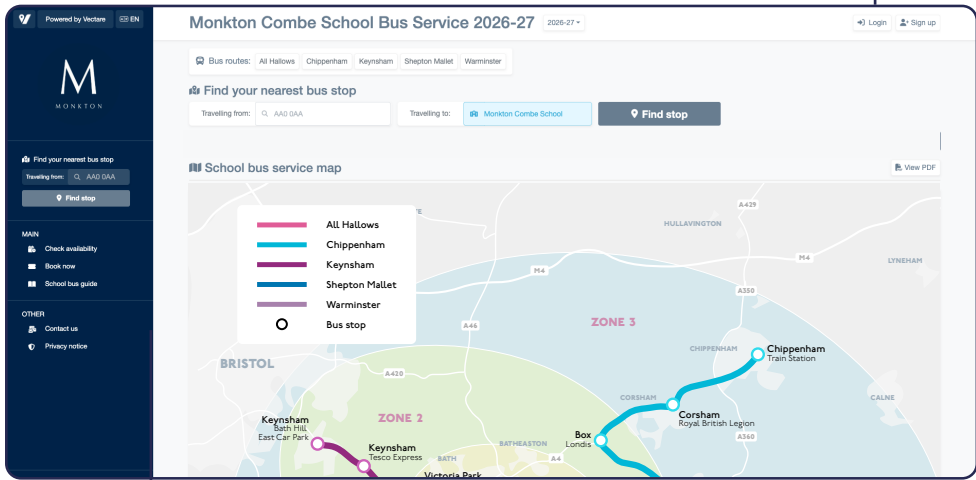

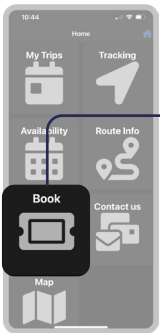

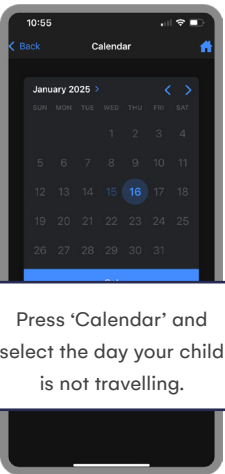
### Making a Booking

Clicking on the booking icon will redirect to the online booking page where you can fill out your details as normal.

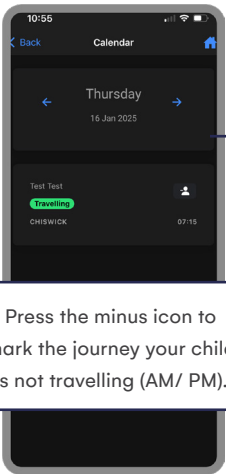
### Marking as Not Travelling

To avoid unnecessary delays, don’t forget to remove your child from the journey list if they are not travelling on any given day. This is easy to do on the Passenger App.

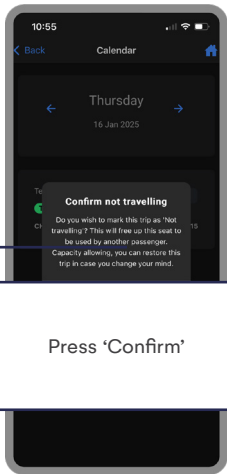
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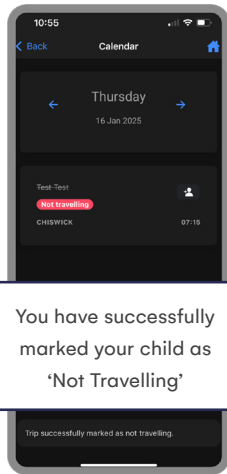
Press ‘Calendar’ and select the day your child is not travelling.

# Terms & Conditions

1. This agreement is made between all school bus passengers, their parents and Monkton Combe School in order to provide safe, comfortable and civilised journeys for all passengers.
2. Arrangements for pupils' journeys to and from the school are the responsibility of their parents. To assist with discharging this responsibility, Monkton Combe School provides a transport service.
3. Transport on the school bus service must be arranged in advance. If you wish to use the school bus service on an ad hoc basis, or to vary the details of your bus travel as a one-off, you should book travel via the website prior to travel. Payment for the service is made online at the time of booking and your child's name will automatically be added to the register. Bookings are to be made online via [monktoncombeschool.vectare.co.uk](http://monktoncombeschool.vectare.co.uk)
4. Bookings on the school bus service are nonrefundable in the event of a pupil failing to travel.
5. It will be the parents' responsibility to inform the school via the 'Contact Us' form on the website if they no longer wish to use the school bus service. A full term's notice must be given by a parent prior to the removal of a pupil from the school bus service (apart from an ad-hoc journey). If an ad hoc journey is cancelled with more than 24 hours' notice the booking can be transferred to another journey. The cancellation can be made on the system but parents need to contact Reception to apply the booking to a future date.
6. No pupil is permitted to travel on the school bus service if not pre-booked for that bus. Other arrangements for journeys to and from school must be made by them or their parents. Pupils must travel to and from Monkton Combe School in full school uniform or a full school PE kit (except on approved non-uniform days).
7. Pupils should be at the bus stop five minutes before the scheduled time of departure to ensure they don't miss the service. In the evening, Prep School parents/guardians should be at the bus stop five minutes before the estimated time of arrival to collect a passenger.
8. Prep School pupils may only leave the bus if they are met by a parent, guardian, or authorised person, or if prior permission has been given for them to disembark unaccompanied. If neither applies, the pupil will be returned to the School at the end of the route and must be collected by a parent or guardian.
9. Good conduct is required at all times. Bullying, shouting, use of foul language, dropping litter, playing music, or any other misbehaviour is strictly forbidden. Snacks and drinks are permitted on the buses on the condition that litter is put in the bins provided or taken for suitable disposal.
10. Except when embarking or disembarking, all passengers must remain seated with their seatbelts fastened correctly.
11. Whilst on a school bus, all passengers must accept without question the authority of a transport company official or school member or staff who may ask them to obey any reasonable instruction such as to pick up litter, desist from certain actions or to move to a different seat.
12. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in disciplinary action, including temporary or permanent withdrawal of permission to use the school bus service.
13. Monkton Combe School aims for 95% of journeys to operate within the transport industry window of tolerance of one minute early to five minutes late, however, timings may vary due to traffic conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Drivers will not wait past the scheduled departure time. This will not apply to the afternoon journeys due to having estimated journey times that will change as a result of traffic, roadworks and number of pupils aboard.
